ADA Paratransit Services

WHAT IS ADA PARATRANSIT SERVICE?

A door-to-door bus service provided by Wichita Transit for customers with disabilities or health conditions that prevent them from using the fixed route bus service for some or all of their travel needs.

WHO CAN USE ADA PARATRANSIT SERVICE?

Anyone who is unable to get to and from a bus stop, get on or off the bus, or ride the fixed route bus by themselves because of their disability or health condition.

WHEN IS ADA PARATRANSIT SERVICE AVAILABLE?

During all fixed route bus service operating times.

Monday through Friday from 5:30 AM until 7:30 PM

Saturday from 6:00 AM until 6:30 PM

WHERE DOES THE ADA PARATRANSIT SERVICE GO?

HOW DO I BECOME ELIGIBLE FOR ADA PARATRANSIT SERVICE?

Before you can use paratransit services, you must complete an application and submit it to Wichita Transit for review. Once the application has been processed, you will receive a letter letting you know of your eligibility status and information on how to use the service.
